Ambulance Service (Animal):

Persons in need of the ambulance van to transport sick, injured or aged animals may dial 70159 on week days between 9-30 a.m. and 4 p.m. and on Sundays from 10 a.m, to 1 p.m. The Society for Prevention of Cruelty to Animals (SPCA) will carry free of cost ownerless animals in need of medical help when it receives complaints.

Autorickshaw Fares:

Each km. Re 1/- minimum charge Re. 2/-. If 3 passengers are carried 25% of the total fare extra. Waiting charges: first five minutes free and thereafter 50 paise for every 15 minute or part thereof.

Auto drivers are permitted to charge not more than one and a half times of the actual fare chargeable as per meter reading for the journeys beyond the Corporation limits of Bangalore between 10 p.m. and 5 a.m.

Taxi Fares:

Rs. 2/- per km., minimum Rs. 4/-, waiting charges Rs. 10/- per hour as part thereof.



BANGALORE

Bangalore is the principal administrative, commer cial and industrial centre of Karnataka State. Situated in the south eastern quadrant of the State at 12°8, north latitude and 77°37' longitude at an altitude of 920 meters (3021 feet) above sea level, including all the extensions.

History:

Bangalore was founded by Kempe Gowda-1 in 1537 A.D. With the permission of the then Vijayanagar Emperor, he erected a strong mud fort and constructed Gavi Gangadhareswara temple at Gavipuram and Basava Temple at Basavangudi. He predicted a great future for the town and actually built four watch-towers at four elevated points around the town prophesing the extent to which the city would grow. The city has grown far beyond the limits visualised by him.

Climate:

Bangalore is endowed by nature with a very salubrious and equable climate. The mean temperature in the warmest month (April) is 27.1°C (80.88F) and in the coldest month (January) it is 20.48C (68.8F). The maximum temperature during the day rarely exceds 34°C (93.8F) in summer (April, May) and the minimum seldom falls below 15.5° (60 F) on winter nights (December February). The atmosphere is neither too humid nor too dry.

Ralinfall:

Banglore receives the benefit of the South West and North East monsoons. The average annual rainfall is 87 centimetres. October and November are rainy months. Occasional rains occur during, June, July and August. December to March is practically dry.

City Administration:

The administration of the city vests with the Corporation of the City of Bangalore, constituted under the City

of Bangalore Municipal Corporation Act LXIX of 1949.

Population:

The increase in population of Bangalore is very rapid since 1955. From 10 lakhs in 1935, it went up to 20 lakhs in 1970 and it is estimated to have crossed 32 lakhs today.

Languages:

The main languages spoken are: Kannada 31% Tamil 27%; Telugu 17%: Hindustani/Urdu 15%; other languages 10%.

Cultural Activities:

Bangalore is an important centre for cultural, religious and social activities. Some institutions arrange periodical exhibitions, recitals, dramas, music and dance performances, lectures, symposia and group discussions that entertain and educate. Some of the daily programmes appear under 'In the City To-day', in Deccan Herald, Indian Express, The Hindu, The Times and some Kannada dailies.

Every Friday evenings (6-30 p. m) Cultural programmes are arranged at the State Youth Centre, Nrupa-


Cubbon Park:

Cubbon Park, in front of Vidhana Soudha, stretches over an area of about 300 acres with its beautifully laid out lawns, grassy expanse, flowering trees, a water fountain, a play ground, band stand and a restaurant. Within the park are situated the Public Library, Jawahar Bala Bhavan (children's theatre), the Government Museum, Aquarium and the Century Club.

To provide amusement and recreation to the children, a section of the park is provided with children's playground. A mini train operates from 3 to 7 p.m. on

all days except Monday which is the weekly holiday. On General Holidays, it runs from 10-30 a.m. to 1.00 p. m. and from 3-00 to 8-00 p.m.

Vidhana Soudha: Phone: 79401

Built in 1954, Vidhana Soudha is a massive and imposing structure in granite in neo-Dravidian style, overlooking the expansive Cubbon Park. The four-storyed ornamental structure, with towering columns, captivating frescoes and carvings, has a total plinth area of over 5,05,000 square feet. The building houses both the Houses of the State Legislature and accommodates the entire Secretariat and several Government offices. It is open for public in the evenings after office hours.

The Trade Centre situated by the side of the Visveswaraya Museum, Kasturba Road, is established to serve the manufacturers in Karnataka. It advises manufacturers on its production and selling problems and assists them in promoting exports. Some of the products manufactured in Karnataka are exhibited here.

Visveswaraya Industrial & Technological Museum:



Karnataka State Government Museum:

1866. Specimens of works of antiquity and ancient art such as sculpture, coins and inscriptions found in different parts of Karnataka have been kept for display. The Museum has an attractive collection of specimens of arehaeological and natural history, numismatics, ethnology, art and industrial art. Working hours: 9 a.m. to 4-30 p.m. on all days except Wednesdays and General Holidays.

Venkatappa Art Gallery:

A wing of the State Government Museum, Venkatappa Art Gallery is an interesting place of visit. Water colour paintings, Plaster of Paris works and other works of art of the famous artist Venkatappa and some contemporary artists are on display. There is also a separate section for the wooden sculptures of Major Cheppudira Ponnappa Rajaram. Attached to the Art Gallery is an exhibition hall which is available on rent to artists for exhibiting their works of art.

Government Aquarium:

The Government Aquarium in the Cubbon Park (Opposite Queen's statue), maintained by the Department of Fisheries, houses 75 kinds of fishes. Entrance fee: Children 25 paise. Adults 50 paise. Working hours 10 a.m. to 7.30 p.m. Weekly Holiday: Thursday.



Lal Bagh:

Phone: 602231. A rich and beautifully laid out garden, situated about 2 km, south east of the City Market, is a place of rest and relaxation. Covering an area of about 240 acres, the garden contains artistically laid out expansive lawns, flower beds, fountains and a

rare and valuable collection of tropical and sub-tropical plants that attract the visitors.

The Lal Bagh garden houses the offices of the Mysore Horticultural Society. Phone: 603781. There is a Sales Depot of the Society, open between 8 a.m. and 12 noon (except on Sundays and Government Holidays) from where selected seedlings, plants etc. can be purchased.

A spacious Glass House situated inside the park, artistically built with crystal glass roofing is available on hire for functions, exhibitions etc. Horticultural shows are arranged here twice a year, i.e. in February and August and prizes are given away for the best flowers and vegetables grown and displayed in the show. Prizes are also given for the best maintained private gardens in the city.

Indian Institute of Science:

Malleswaram, Bangalore-3. Phone: 36 4411. The Indian Institute of Science (popularly known as the Tata Institute), established in 1909 is today one of the foremost scientific institutions in the country for post-graduate specialised research and abvanced instruction in science and engineering.

Karnataka State Arts and Crafts Emporium:



Kumara Krupa Road, Bangalore-1. Phone: 71967. Pictures depicting the life of Gandhiji, photostat copies of letters written by Gandhiji to some personalities are displayed here. The picture gallery is open between 12 noon and 6 p.m. Closed on Sundays and General Holidays.

The Bangalore Palace:

Built in the style of Windsor Castle, London, the Bangalore Palace in the midst of a well laid out garden in the High Grounds, north west of Vidhana Soudha is of architectural interest.

Tippu's Palace:


Phone: 606836. About I km. from the City Market, Tippu's Palace just behind Sri Venkataramana temple is one of the national protected monuments. Open to public from 6 a.m. to 6 p.m.

Ulsoor Lake:


Phone: 53114. The Ulsoor lake covering an area of 15 sq. kms attracts visitors by its picturesque scenery. Boating facilities have been provided by the Corporation of the City of Bangalore. Fibreglass rowing boats, motor boats and sailor boats are available on hourly hire basis. Working hours: 9 a.m. to 6 p.m. Weekly holiday: Wednesday. There is also a modern public swimming pool.

Gavi Gangadhareswara Cave Temple, Gavipuram.

Situated about 3 km from the City Market, this is one of the ancient temples cut out in rock, probably of the 9th century.

Bull (Basava) Temple, Basavanagudi.

About a kilometre from the above temple is Basava temple. The monolithic idol is 20 feet long and 15 feet high. The temple is open from 8 a.m. to 8 p.m.

Sri Veeranjaneya Temple, Mahalakshmi Layout:
Situated about 3.5 km from the City Railway
Station, the idol is 22 feet high, carved out of a single rock.

Some Places of Interest at Short Distances from Bangalore

Bannerghatta National Park (Safari Park):

21 kms south-east of Bangalore. There are wild animals like bisons, lion cubs, crocodiles and tamed elephants. the charges to go round the Park Rs. 3/- per adult and Rs. 2/- for children.

Belur and Halebid: Belur is 220 kms from Bangalore, Halebid is 15 kms east of Belur. Known for temples with an amazing variety of carvings in stone.

Chamarajasager Reservoir: (Thippagondanahalli): 35 kms from Bangalore on the Magadi Road. Supplements water supply to Bangalore.

Devarayanadurga: 79 kms from Bangalore. There are temples dedicated to Sri Ugra Narasimha and Yoga Narasimha. Sri Bhoga Narasimha Temple is on the lower hill.


Ghati Subramanya: 53 kms from Bangalore. The temple of Lord Subramanya here is an ancient one.

Hessaraghatta: A well-known agricultural and fruit farm, 29 kms from Bangalore. Picturesque with a lake. There is a Boat Club.

Kaiwara: 75 kms from Bangalore on the Bangalore-Cuddappa Road, Kaiwara is a pilgrim Centre.

Kanva Reservior: 69 kms from Bangalore via Ramanagaram.

Kolar Gold Fields: 160 kms from Bangalore. Deepest working gold mines.

Savanadurga: 60 kms from Bangalore on the Magadi Road. There is a temple dedicated to Sri Basaveswara on the Hill. At the foot of the Hill are temples dedicated to Sri Veerabhadraswamy and Sri Narasimhaswamy.

Shivaganga: An enchanting hill 4559 feet above sea level, 60 kms from Bangalore, is a pilgrim centre with the cave temples of Sri Gangadhareswara and Honnadevi and several thirthas.

Sivasamudram: 120 kms from Bangalore, Known for twin water falls, Gaganachukki and Bharachukki and hydro electric station. There are temples dedicated to Vishnu and Shiva.


Siddaganga: A place of pilgrimage and an educational centre, 80 kms from Bangalore.


Somanathapura: 123 kms from Bangalore or 45 kms east of Mysore or 24 kms from Srirangapatna. Sri Prasanna Chenna Keshava temple built here in 1268 A. D with exquisite carvings is a good example of Hoysala architecture.

Sravanabelagola: 170 kms from Bangalore or 51 kms from Hassan. The colossal monolithic statue of Gomateswara stands erect 57 feet high.

Srirangapatna: 123 kms from Bangalore on the Bangalore-Mysore Road. Historic place. Sri Ranganathaswamy temple is here.

Kokrebellur: 10 kms to the east of Maddur Kokrebellur is a village frequented by painted storks and pelicans during breeding season (January to end of June).

Magadi: 48 kms from Bangalore. There are temples of Sri Rameswara, Gangadhareswara. Sri Veerabhadra and Sri Ranganatha.

Mahadeswara Hill: Situated in picturesque surroundings A pilgrim centre 160 kms from Bangalore via Kollegal.

Mekedatu: A beauty spot about 98 kms from Bangalore via Kanakapura. Sangama, the confluence of the rivers Kaveri and Arkavati is about 5 kms from here.

Melkote: A sacred place, about 130 kms from Bangalore. Sri Vashnava preceptor Sri Ramanuja lived and taught here for nearly 14 years in the 12th century. The temple of Tirunarayana located on the lower hill and Sri Yoga Narasimha on the top of the hill are famous.

Muthyala Maduvu: About 45 kms from Bangalore via Anekal. A picnic spot with a waterfall and picturesque scenery.

Nandi Hill: A well-known summer resort, 59 kms from Bangalore.

Mysore: 136 kms from Bangalore. An important educational and industrial centre. Mysore Zoological Garden, Sri Chamarajendra Technical Institute, Chamarajendra Arts Gallery and the Palace are some places of interest. Chamundi Hill is 8 kms from Mysore. About 12 kms from Mysore are Brindavan Gardens.

Ramohalli: 25 kms from Bangalore. Known for the Banyan tree covering an area of about 4 acres by its branches. At 20.5 kms after Kengeri on Bangalore Mysore Road, take the diversion road to the right to reach this place.

Talkad: An ancient town, situated on the left bank of Cauvery, 45 kms south east of Mysore. There are temples of Sri Kirthinarayana, Sri Vaideeswara, Sri Pataleswara and Sri Maraleswara.

Vasanthapura: A small hillock 12 kms to the soutr east of Bangalore. There is a temple dedicated to Sri Vasantha Vallabharayaswamy.

Viduraswatha: A pilgrim centre with a hoary past, 39 kms from Bangalore on the Hindupur-Bangalore line.


